The Mississippi Court of Appeals held that a decedent’s father, as her surviving heir, lacked authority to change the beneficiaries of a life insurance policy owned by decedent on her nephew’s life. The court explained that as no estate was opened and there was no

determination of heirs or appointment of a representative, decedent's father lacked the authority necessary to act on behalf of the estate to change ownership of the life insurance policy and designate himself and decedent's brother as beneficiaries.
