Congress Set to Pass Tax Reform Bill Today

Yesterday both the House and Senate passed the conference report on a party line vote. [No Senate Republicans](#) opposed the tax bill, while [12 House Republicans voted against the measure](#). Because of technical changes made to the conference report in the Senate yesterday, the House will need to vote on the Senate tax bill one more time before it goes to the President's desk. The House is expected to vote on and pass the bill at noon today.
