AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 30 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE ESTATE TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Add new section to Title 30 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strikethrough and insertions
2 as shown by underline as follows:

3 § 1510. Sunset Date.

4 This chapter shall expire after December 31, 2017.

SYNOPSIS

This bill will sunset the Delaware Estate Tax on December 31, 2017.
