### **SECURE Act Included in Year-End Spending Package**

House and Senate negotiators today released the full legislative text to the end-of-the-year appropriations legislation, H.R. 1158 and H.R. 1865, which includes the Setting Every Community Up for Retirement Enhancement (SECURE) Act. The full text of the legislation is available [here](#) and will be considered in both the House and Senate this week. The SECURE Act can be found in Division O of H.R. 1865.
